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18	Plaintiff Michael Chavez, a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis, filed this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 and 42 U.S.C. § 12132 (the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)) on June 19, 2009. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. On April 1, 2011, the Magistrate Judge screened Plaintiff's amended complaint and		
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23	recommended dismissal of this action for failure to state a claim. 28 U.S.C. § 1915A. After receiving two extensions of time, Plaintiff filed his objection on July 5, 2011.		
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25	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § $636(b)(1)(C)$, the Court has conducted a <u>novo</u> review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds the Findings are		
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27	Recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis.
