18	On October 27, 2010, Plaintiff LaMar Singleton ("Plaintiff") filed a complaint against Eli	
19 20	Lilly Co. ("Defendant"). Plaintiff claims that Defendant manufactured, marketed, and sold Zyprexa.	
20	Plaintiff asserts that taking Zyprexa caused him to develop type 2 diabetes, obesity, and permanent	
21 22	nerve damage and pain to both feet and hands. Plaintiff states that his claims against Defendant arise	
22	under the Eighth and Fourteenth Amendments and requests \$13,000,000 in damages.	
23 24	On January 28, 2011, the Court dismissed Plaintiff's complaint and granted Plaintiff 30 days	
24 25	to file an amended complaint. (Doc. 7.) Plaintiff failed to file an amended complaint. On March	
23 26	10, 2011, the Court issued Findings and Recommendations that the matter be dismissed due to	
20 27	Plaintiff's failure to file an amended complaint in compliance with the Court's January 28, 2011, order (Dec. 8). On March 31, 2011, Plaintiff filed a request for an extension of time to file on	
27	order. (Doc. 8.) On March 31, 2011, Plaintiff filed a request for an extension of time to file an amended complaint. (Doc. 9.) Plaintiff asserts that he mailed an amended complaint to the Court	
20	amended comptaint. (Doc. 7.) I famuif asse	rts that ne manee an amendee complaint to the Court

1	on February 16, 2011, but it was lost in the mail. (Doc. 9, 1:11-13.) Plaintiff also asserts that, due	
2	to medical procedures, he has not been able "to concentrate on [his] legal responsibilities." (Doc.	
3	9, 1:19.)	
4	Accordingly, the Court HEREBY ORDERS THAT:	
5	1. The March 10, 2011, Findings and Recommendations are WITHDRAWN;	
6	2. Plaintiff shall file an amended complaint on or before May 31, 2011; and	
7	3. If Plaintiff again fails to file an amended complaint, the Court will recommend that	
8	the action be dismissed.
