20	On March 3, 2016, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations which were

22	Plaintiff filed objections repeating arguments/assertions which were addressed in the findings and		
23	recommendations to which Defendants responded.		
24	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), the court has conducted a		
25	de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the court finds the findings		
26	and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis.

1	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:	
2	1. the Findings and Recommendations, filed on March 3, 2016 (Doc. 55), is adopted	
3	in full;	
4	2. Defendants' motion for partial summary judgment, filed on April 6, 2015 (Doc.	
5	34), is GRANTED;	
6	a. Plaintiff's claim of excessive force against Defendants Chamberlin and	
7	Molina is DISMISSED;	
8	b. Plaintiff's claim for failure-to-protect against Defendants Herrera and	
9	Morse is DISMISSED;	
10	c. this action proceeds forward only on Plaintiff's claims of excessive force	
11	against Defendants Herrera and Morse and for failure-to-protect against	
12	Defendants Chamberlin and Molina.	
13	3. the case is referred back to the Magistrate Judge for further pre-trial matters.	
14	IT IS SO ORDERED.
