GIPSON, et al., 15 Defendants. 16 Plaintiff Ricardo Verduzco is appearing pro se and in forma pauperis in this civil rights action 17 pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 18 19 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 20 On October 14, 2016, the Magistrate Judge issued Findings and Recommendations 21 recommending that Plaintiff's request for injunctive relief be denied. (ECF No. 10.) Specifically, 22 Plaintiff requested an order directing CDCR to stop collecting restitution fine funds from his inmate 23 trust account until the filing fee for this action is paid in full. The Magistrate Judge found that the court

lacks jurisdiction to order CDCR to stop collecting state mandated restitution, as CDCR is not a party

to this action.

In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), the Court has conducted a *de novo* review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds the Findings and Recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis.

## Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. The Findings and Recommendations issued October 14, 2016 (ECF No. 23), are adopted in full; and
- 2. Plaintiff's motion for injunctive relief, filed June 9, 2016 (ECF No. 21), is denied.
