10	pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254. On September 28, 2015, the Court screened the petition in accordance	
18	with Rule 4 of the Rules Governing § 2254 Cases and dismissed the petition with leave to amend	
19	within thirty days. The order provided that if Petitioner failed to file an amended petition within 30	
20	days, the action would be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. Petitioner has not filed an amended	
21	petition.	
22	Conclusion and Recommendation	
23	Accordingly, the undersigned hereby RECOMMENDS that the Court dismiss the petition for	
24	failure to prosecute this action.

20	These Findings and Recommendations will be submitted to the United States District Judge	
27	assigned to the case, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C § 636(b)(1). Within thirty (30) days	
	after being served with these Findings and Recommendations, Petitioner may file written objections 1	

1	with the Court. The document should be captioned "Objections to Magistrate Judge's Findings and	
2	Recommendations." Petitioner is advised that failure to file objections within the specified time may	
3	constitute waiver of the right to appeal the District Court's order. Wilkerson v. Wheeler, 772 F.3d	
4	834, 839 ((9th Cir. 2014) (citing Baxter v. Sullivan, 923 F.2d 1391, 1394 (9th Cir. 1991)). In lieu of	
5	filing objections, Petitioner may file the amended petition within thirty days, and the undersigned	
6	will withdraw these findings and recommendations.
