16	Plaintiff, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, filed this civil rights action seeking
17	relief under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge
18	pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.
19	On November 15, 2012, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations
20	herein which were served on all parties and which contained notice to all parties that any
21	objections to the findings and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days. Neither
22	party has filed objections to the findings and recommendations.
23	Although it appears from the file that plaintiff's copy of the findings and
24	recommendations was returned, plaintiff was properly served. It is the plaintiff's responsibility
25	to keep the court apprised of his current address at all times. Pursuant to Local Rule 182(f),
26	service of documents at the record address of the party is fully effective.
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1	The court has reviewed the file and finds the findings and recommendations to be
2	supported by the record and by the magistrate judge's analysis. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY
3	ORDERED that:
4	1. The findings and recommendations filed November 15, 2012, are adopted in
5	full; and
6	2. This action is dismissed pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b).
