The matter was referred to a United 20 States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local General Order No. 262. 21 On May 1, 2007, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein 22 which were served on all parties and which contained notice to all parties that any objections to 23 the findings and recommendations were to be filed within twenty days. Petitioner has filed 24 objections to the findings and recommendations. 25 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 72-26 304, this court has conducted a <u>de novo</u> review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the

entire file, the court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis.
