16	Some things just fall between the cracks. On August 13,
17	2003, the court entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction
18	and Other Relief (ECF No. 25) against defendant Gregory P. Waldon
19	in this enforcement action brought by the Securities and Exchange
20	Commission ("Commission"). The judgment called for installment
21	payments by Waldon to the Clerk of the Court, totaling \$90,000 in
22	disgorgement. The judgment further called for the disgorged funds
23	to be "distributed pursuant to a Court-approved plan to be proposed
24	by motion of the Commission."
25	The \$90,000 in disgorgement payments were completed on
26	September 20, 2005. However, the Final Judgment contained no

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1	explicit deadline for filing the Commission's motion proposing a
2	distribution plan, and no such motion was ever made.
3	Accordingly, the Commission is hereby ordered to file, within
4	sixty (60) days of the date of this order, a plan for distributing
5	these funds, as contemplated in the Final Judgment.
6	IT IS SO ORDERED.
