Plaintiff, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, has filed this civil rights action seeking relief under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local General Order No. 262.

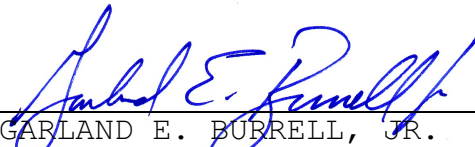

5 damage claim that his Eighth Amendment rights were violated when he was deprived of outdoor
6 exercise during the four lockdown periods is denied.
