ORDER & FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Plaintiff is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis. On March 18, 2010, the court found plaintiff's complaint stated a colorable claim for money damages against defendants Paulsen, Nokrashy and Jone, but dismissed claims against Post with leave to amend.
