7 3. This action is remanded to the Superior Court of the State of California in and
8 for the County of Solano; and

9 4. Defendants' motions to dismiss, Dckt. Nos. 60 and 64, and defendants' motion
10 to strike the lis pendens, Dckt. No. 67, are denied without prejudice to them being re-filed in the
11 state court action.
