Plaintiff, who is proceeding without counsel and has not paid the fee ordinarily required to file an action in this court, previously filed an incomplete application to proceed in forma pauperis pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a). (See Dkt. No. 2). Because the incomplete application prevented the court from properly evaluating whether plaintiff should be granted leave to proceed in forma pauperis, the undersigned granted plaintiff twenty-one days within which to either: (1) file a completed application to proceed in forma pauperis, or (2) file the appropriate initial filing fee of \$350.00. (Dkt. No. 3 at 2.) Plaintiff did not submit a completed application or the appropriate initial filing fee.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that:

1. Plaintiff’s application to proceed in forma pauperis be denied; and
