19	and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days. No objections were filed.

24	Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that:	
25	1. The proposed Findings and Recor	nmendations filed September 15, 2016 (ECF
26	No. 189), are ADOPTED in full;	
27	2. Defendants' motion for summary	judgment (ECF No. 163) is GRANTED in part and
28	DENIED in part as follows:	

1	a. Summary judgment is denied as to plaintiff's FDCPA claim against Ocwen
2	for violation of 15 U.S.C. § 1692d(5) and (6); and
3	b. The motion is GRANTED in all other respects, and
4	c. This action proceeds on plaintiff's FDCPA claim against Ocwen for violation
5	of 15 U.S.C. § 1692d(5) and (6);
6	3. Defendants' motion to dissolve the preliminary injunction and for an order releasing
7	the bond (ECF No. 162) is GRANTED;
8	4. The preliminary injunction entered on April 26, 2013 is DISSOLVED, the related
9	bond is exonerated, and the Clerk is directed to release those funds to defendants; and
10	5. The Clerk is directed to serve a copy of this order on the court's Financial Division.
11	IT IS SO ORDERED.
