17	Plaintiff, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, has filed this civil rights action seeking relief	
18	under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to	
19	28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.	
20	On May 18, 2016, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein which	
21	were served on all parties and which contained notice to all parties that any objections to the	
22	findings and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days. Plaintiff has filed	
23	objections to the findings and recommendations.	
24	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 304, this	
25	court has conducted a <u>de novo</u> review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the	
26	court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper	
27	analysis.	
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1	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:	
2	1. The findings and recommendations filed May 18, 2016, are adopted in full; and	
3	2. Defendant Voss' motion to dismiss filed January 21, 2016, ECF No. 21, is denied	
4	without prejudice.	
5	3. It is further ordered that:	
6	a. The Clerk of Court is directed to send plaintiff, together with a copy of this	
7	order, three (3) USM-285 forms; and	
8	b. Plaintiff is directed to submit to the court, within sixty days after the filing date	
9	of this order, a newly-completed USM-285 form for each defendant, or show good cause why he	
10	cannot provide such information.	
11	4. This case is referred back to the magistrate judge for further proceedings.
