This proceeding was referred to the undersigned by E.D. Cal. R. 302(c)(21). 18 On December 3, 2015, the undersigned recommended that this action be dismissed for 19 lack of prosecution after plaintiff repeatedly failed to file a statement establishing that he had 20 submitted the required service documents to the U.S. Marshal. ECF No. 10. On December 8, 21 2015, however, a Waiver of Service of Summons was filed, showing service of the summons and 22 complaint on defendant City of Sacramento. ECF No. 11.
