

1 The deadline has passed and plaintiff has not filed an opposition or statement of non-
2 opposition to the pending motion, nor has he responded to the court's order to show cause.

3 Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED that the hearing on defendant's motion to dismiss,
4 currently set for October 5, 2016, is VACATED. Defense counsel's request to appear
5 telephonically (ECF No. 13) is denied as moot.

6 Further, it is RECOMMENDED that this action be dismissed for failure to prosecute and
7 to comply with court orders and the court's local rules. *See* Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b); Cal. E.D. L.R.
8 110.

9 These findings and recommendations are submitted to the United States District Judge
10 assigned to the case, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1). Within fourteen days
11 after being served with these findings and recommendations, plaintiff may file written objections
12 with the court. Such a document should be captioned "Objections to Magistrate Judge's Findings
13 and Recommendations." Failure to file objections within the specified time may waive the right
14 to appeal the District Court's order. *Turner v. Duncan*, 158 F.3d 449, 455 (9th Cir. 1998);
15 *Martinez v. Ylst*, 951 F.2d 1153 (9th Cir. 1991).
