On October 19, 2023, the Magistrate Judge filed findings and recommendations (ECF No. 12 in the -881 case; ECF No. 15 in the -882 case), which were served on the parties, and which contained notice that any objections to the findings and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen (14) days. No objections were filed. Accordingly, the court presumes that any findings of fact are correct. *See Orand v. United States*, 602 F.2d 207, 208 (9th Cir. 1979). The

3 The Court has reviewed the applicable legal standards and, good cause  
4 appearing, concludes that it is appropriate to adopt the findings and  
5 recommendations in full. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 6 1. The findings and recommendations (ECF No. 12 in the -881 case; ECF No. 15 in  
7 the -882 case) are ADOPTED IN FULL;
- 8 2. These actions are DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE pursuant to Federal Rule  
9 of Civil Procedure 41(b); and
- 10 3. The Clerk of Court is directed to CLOSE these cases.
