

1 were still unknown. To date, Petitioner has not provided the Court with a current
2 mailing address.

3 Civil Local Rule 83.11.b provides:

4 A party proceeding pro se must keep the court and opposing parties
5 advised as to current address. If mail directed to a pro se plaintiff by the
6 clerk at the plaintiff's last designated address is returned by the Post
7 Office, and if such plaintiff fails to notify the court and opposing parties
8 within 60 days thereafter of the plaintiff's current address, the court may
9 dismiss the action without prejudice for failure to prosecute.

10 As of the date of this Order, more than 60 days have elapsed since the Report
11 was returned by the Post Office as undeliverable. Given Petitioner's failure to apprise
12 the Court of his current mailing address within the time allotted by Civil Local Rule
13 83.11.b, the Petition is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE** for failure to
14 prosecute. The Clerk of Court is directed to enter **FINAL JUDGMENT** accordingly,
15 and then to **TERMINATE** this case.
