**ORDER AFFIRMING RECOMMENDED DECISION

On October 14, 2016, the United States Magistrate Judge filed with the court, with a copy to the plaintiff, his Recommended Decision After Screening Plaintiff's Complaint Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e).
