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**ORDER ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDED DECISION OF THE

The United States Magistrate Judge, John H. Rich III, filed his Recommended Decision (ECF No. 18) on Emily A.'s Social Security Disability and Supplemental Security Income appeal with the Court on April 23, 2018, pursuant to 28 U.S.C.A. § 636(b)(1)(B) (2018) and Fed.
