The United States Magistrate Judge, John C. Nivison, filed his Recommended Decision (ECF No. 16) on Richard K.’s Period of Disability and Disability Insurance Benefits appeal with the Court on September 5, 2018, pursuant to 28 U.S.C.A. § 636(b)(1)(B) (West 2018) and Fed.
