ORDER AFFIRMING RECOMMENDED DECISION

On January 19, 2022, the United States Magistrate Judge filed with the Court his Recommended Decision on Defendants’ Motion for Summary Judgment and on Plaintiff’s Motion for Partial Summary Judgment (ECF No. 143).
