## ORDER AFFIRMING THE RECOMMENDED DECISION OF THE MAGISTRATE JUDGE

On July 7, 2022, the United States Magistrate Judge filed with the Court, with copy to the Plaintiff, her Recommended Decision after a preliminary review of the Plaintiff's Complaint under 28 U.S.C. § 1915. In addition, I hereby place Matthew Jones on notice that filing restrictions "may be in the offing." *Cok v. Family Court of Rhode Island*, 985 F.2d 32, 35 (1st Cir.

1993). This represents the "cautionary order" of which *Cok* speaks. *Id*. Groundless and inappropriate filings will not be tolerated.
