DECISION AND ORDER

ORDERED, that Defendant's Cross-Motion for judgment on the pleadings is **DENIED**; and

it is further

ORDERED, and the Complaint (Dkt. No. 1) is REMANDED to the Commissioner for

further proceedings consistent with the Report-Recommendation; and it is further

ORDERED, that the Clerk serve a copy of this Order on all parties.
