DECISION and ORDER		
Plaintiff filed this action in November 2006, pursuant to 42 U.S.C. §§ 405(g),		
1383(c)(3) seeking review of a final decision of the Commissioner of Social Security denying		
her application for disability insurance benefits and Supplement Security Income. By Report-		
Recommendation dated June 4, 2009, the Honorable Victor E. Bianchini, United States		
Magistrate Judge, recommended that defendant's motion for judgment on the pleadings		
should be denied; plaintiff's cross motion for judgment on the pleadings should be granted in		
part and denied in part and remanded for further reconsideration.		

Based upon a careful review of the entire file and the recommendations of

Magistrate Judge Bianchini, the Report-Recommendation is accepted and adopted in whole.

ORDERED that

3. This matter is REMANDED to the Commissioner for further consideration consistent with the Report-Recommendation.
