JAMES S. GWIN, UNITED STATES DISTRICT JUDGE:

On September 11, 2015, Plaintiff Joseph Zickes filed a complaint alleging violations of his rights under the First, Fourth, Fifth, Sixth, Eighth, and/or Fourteenth Amendments to the U.S. Constitution.<sup>1</sup> Plaintiff Zickes named Bryan Smith, Michael Carroll, Lucy Rodriguez, Cuyahoga County, and the Cuyahoga County Executive as defendants. On September 29, 2015, Lucy Rodriguez filed a motion to be dismissed as a party.<sup>2</sup> Plaintiff Zickes filed an amended complaint on November, 3, 2015. Lucy Rodriguez then filed a motion for judgment on the pleadings on November 17, 2015.<sup>3</sup> Because Rodriguez filed her motion to dismiss before Zickes filed his amended complaint and because Rodriguez has now filed a motion for judgment on the pleadings, this Court **DENIES as MOOT** Rodriguez' motion to dismiss.
