**DECISION AND ENTRY: (1) ADOPTING THE REPORT AND  
RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE  
(Doc. 11); (2) OVERRULING PLAINTIFF’S OBJECTIONS (Doc. 12) ; AND

This case is before the Court pursuant to the Order of General Reference in the United States District Court for the Southern District of Ohio Western Division to United States Magistrate Judge Sharon L. Ovington. Pursuant to such reference, the Magistrate Judge reviewed the pleadings filed with this Court, and, on July 20, 2011, submitted a Report and Recommendations. (Doc. 11). Subsequently, Plaintiff filed Objections to the Report and Recommendations (Doc. 12) and the Defendant responded (Doc. 13).

As required by 29 U.S.C. § 636(b) and Fed. R. Civ. P. 72(b), the Court has reviewed the comprehensive findings of the Magistrate Judge and considered *de novo* all of the filings in this matter.
