
Given that Plaintiff has failed to set forth the denial of a constitutional right and that this Court's decision herein would not be debatable among jurists of reason, the Petitioner's anticipated request for Certificate of Appealability is denied. Moreover, given that any appeal from this decision would be objectively

frivolous, this Court denies leave to appeal *in forma pauperis*.

Judgment will be entered ordered in favor of Respondent and against Petitioner herein, denying and dismissing Petitioner's motion under 28 U.S.C. § 2255. Petitioner's Request for an Evidentiary Hearing (Doc. #1) is denied as moot.

The captioned cause is hereby ordered terminated upon the docket records of the United States District Court for the Southern District of Ohio, Western Division, at Dayton.
