This case is before the Court pursuant to the Order of General Reference in the United States District Court for the Southern District of Ohio Western Division to United States Magistrate Judge Sharon L. Ovington. Pursuant to such reference, the Magistrate Judge reviewed the pleadings filed with this Court, and, on May 30, 2013 submitted Report and Recommendations. (Doc. 7). Defendant did not file objections.

4. This case is **CLOSED** on the docket of this Court.
