
DECISION AND ENTRY ADOPTING UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE
JUDGE'S REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION (DOC. #43);
OVERRULING PLAINTIFF'S OBJECTIONS THERETO (DOC. #44);
SUSTAINING DEFENDANT'S MOTION FOR ORDER CERTIFYING THAT
APPEAL IS NOT TAKEN IN GOOD FAITH AND DENYING *IN FORMA*
PAUPERIS STATUS ON APPEAL (DOC. #42); INSTRUCTIONS TO
CLERK OF COURT

Based on the reasoning and citations of authority set forth in the United States Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendation (Doc. #43), issued February 25, 2013, as well as upon a thorough *de novo* review of this Court's file and the applicable law, this Court ADOPTS said judicial filing in its entirety, and OVERRULES Plaintiff's Objections thereto (Doc. #44).

The Court SUSTAINS Defendant's Motion for Order Certifying that Appeal is Not Taken in Good Faith. Doc. #42. Plaintiff is therefore denied the right to proceed *in forma pauperis* on appeal. Pursuant to Federal Rule of Appellate

Procedure 24(a)(4)(B), the Clerk of Court shall so notify the Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals.
