DECISION AND ENTRY ADOPTING THE REPORT AND RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE MAGISTRATE JUDGE (Doc. 8) AND DISMISSING ALL CLAIMS ASSERTED BY PLAINTIFF ST. G. TECH, INC.
