On March 31, 2010, plaintiff Marc Draper filed a pro se complaint which names the following seven defendants: (1) the Darby Township Police Department; (2) Officer Sweeney of the Darby Township Police Department ; (3) Enforcement Towing Co.; (4) the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation; (5) A-Auto; (6) Larry McKee<sup>1</sup>; and (7) the late Judge Edward Zetusky of the Delaware County Court of Common Pleas. Plaintiff's complaint alleges that his vehicle was impounded in violation of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code. *See* Dkt. 4, at 4 (alleging that his Plymouth Neon was
