## <u>ORDER</u>

AND NOW, this 20th day of August, 2015, upon consideration of Defendant Salvation Army's Motion for Summary Judgment (Doc. No. 30) and memorandum and statement of facts in support thereof (Doc. Nos. 31 and 32), filed in the above captioned matter on October 10, 2014, and in further consideration of Plaintiff's responses thereto (Doc.
