MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER

The Court, having reviewed Plaintiff Michael P Smith's Application for Attorney Fees under the Equal Access to Justice Act, (Dkt. #27), and the Commissioner's Response, (Dkt. #29), 1 wherein the Commissioner does not object to the requested fee, finds that Plaintiff's Motion is well taken and should be granted. Accordingly,

¹ The Commissioner contends that a mathematical error exists in Plaintiff's calculations and the attorneys' fees requested is actually \$6,025.50. (Dkt. #29). However, the Commissioner erroneously used \$200.85 as the hourly rate, (Dkt. #29), instead of the hourly rate utilized by Plaintiff, \$200.83. (Dkt. #27). Because the Court finds that Plaintiff has calculated the correct amount, \$6,024.90, (Dkt. #27), the Court awards such amount.
