Plaintiff filed a prisoner civil rights complaint,¹ and was granted *in forma pauperis* status.² However, Plaintiff has not complied with the Court's February 28, 2011, order to file within thirty days a "certified copy of the trust fund account statements . . . for the 6-month period immediately preceding the filing of the complaint . . . obtained from the appropriate official of each prison at which prisoner is confined."³ Indeed, the order was returned to sender as undeliverable. Plaintiff has not since updated his address with the Court.
