Plaintiff filed a prisoner civil rights complaint,¹ and was granted *in forma pauperis* status.² However, Plaintiff has not obeyed the Court's July 25, 2018, order to file within thirty days a "certified copy of the trust fund account statements . . . for the 6-month period immediately preceding the filing of the complaint . . . obtained from the appropriate official of each prison at which prisoner is confined."³

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that--for failure to obey the Court's order and to prosecute this case--Plaintiff's action is DISMISSED without prejudice. This case is CLOSED.
