**MEMORANDUM OPINION**

By Memorandum Order entered on April 30, 2021, the Court conditionally docketed Plaintiff's action. On August 25, 2023, the United States Postal Service returned an August 14, 2023 Memorandum Order to the Court marked, "RETURN TO SENDER" and "Inmate Released." Plaintiff's failure to contact the Court and provide a current address indicates his lack of interest in prosecuting this action. *See* Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b). Accordingly, the action will be DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE.
