MEMORANDUM OPINION

On February 14, 2024, the Court conditionally docketed Plaintiff's action. (ECF No. 3.) Plaintiff requested leave to proceed *in forma pauperis*. By Memorandum Order entered on March 25, 2024, (ECF No. 7), the Court directed Plaintiff to pay an initial partial filing fee of \$7.70 or state under penalty of perjury that he did not have sufficient assets to pay such a fee within thirty (30) days of the date of entry thereof. *See* 28 U.S.C. § 1915(b)(1). Plaintiff has neither paid the initial partial filing fee nor averred that he cannot pay such a fee. Therefore, Plaintiff is not entitled to proceed *in forma pauperis*. Plaintiff's disregard of the Court's directives warrants dismissal of the action. Accordingly, the action will be DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE.
