PER CURIAM.

No motion for pretrial detention was filed, and the order does not include findings to support the denial. Consequently, we grant the petition and remand to the trial court to either provide findings to support the denial or set an expedited hearing to determine the issue of pretrial release or detention according to Rules 3.131 and 3.132 of the Florida Rules of Criminal Procedure. *Lee v. State*, 956 So. 2d 1292 (Fla. 4th DCA 2007); *Resendes v. Bradshaw*, 935 So. 2d 19 (Fla. 4th DCA 2006).
