ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

Upon review of the record, it appears that: (1) on June 24, 2007, Defendants-Appellants David Kim, New Hope All Nations Fellowship, New Hope All Nations, and All Nations Fellowship, filed a notice of appeal; (2) on August 24, 2007, Appellants filed the statement of jurisdiction; (3) on October 2, 2007, Appellants obtained an extension of time until October 24, 2007 to file the opening brief; (4) Appellants failed to file the opening brief; (5) on November 2, 2007, the appellate clerk informed Appellants: (a) the time to file the opening brief expired, (b) the matter would be called to the attention of the
