IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the judgment of the first circuit court¹ filed on April 19, 2001, from which the appeal is taken, is (1) affirmed as to Counts I and II of the complaint, (2) affirmed in part as to Count III and vacated and remanded with respect to Plaintiff-Appellant's claim that he was illegally detained at the time of the subject traffic incident, and (3) affirmed in part as to Count IV of the complaint, and vacated
