## ORDER

Upon consideration of the application for a writ of mandamus filed by Petitioner Carina Ann Humphries, the papers in support, and the records and files herein, it appears that: (1) Petitioner is seeking review of the orders denying Petitioners' ex parte applications for payment pursuant to HRS § 802-7 of expert fees at state expense in <a href="State v.
