Upon review of the record, it appears that the claims  
by the plaintiffs in consolidated Civil No. 94-0554 and Civil No.

95-0621 were resolved by summary judgment and dismissal orders and by judgments awarding damages, but the orders and judgments were not reduced to a single judgment resolving the claims of all the plaintiffs in the consolidated cases. See HRCP 58; Jenkins v. Cades Schutte Fleming & Wright, 76 Hawai'i 115, 119-120, 869 P.2d 1334, 1338-39 (1994) (In a multiple-claim or multiple-party circuit court case in which all claims of all the parties have been resolved, an appeal may be taken after entry of a judgment that, on its face, resolves all claims of all the parties.). Absent entry of a judgment resolving the claims of all plaintiffs in consolidated Civil No. 94-0554 and Civil No. 95-0621, this appeal is premature and we lack jurisdiction. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this appeal is dismissed for lack of appellate jurisdiction.
