IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the motion is denied.

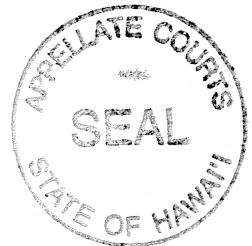
