**WRIT DENIED.** The holding in **Martinez v. Ryan**, \_\_\_  
U.S. \_\_\_, 132 S.Ct. 1309, 182 L.Ed.2d 272 (2012) appears  
to affect federal habeas corpus proceedings for defendants  
alleging ineffective assistance of counsel, but it does not  
create any right enforceable in state criminal  
postconviction proceedings. Accordingly, the trial court  
did not err in denying relator's application for  
postconviction relief as untimely under La. Code Crim. P.  
art. 930.8.
