McClendon, J., dissents and would grant the writ. Under *Colvin v. Louisiana Patient's Comp. Fund Oversight Bd.*, 2006-1104 (La. 1/17/07), 947 So.2d 15, "the place where the operative facts occurred which support plaintiff's entitlement to recovery is where the cause of action aris[es]." The portion of the May 1, 2014 judgment of the trial court which ordered that "the claim of plaintiff, Barry Musemeche, of defamation filed in the above captioned matter against defendants Bossier Parish School Board and Nichole Bourgeois which occurred in East Baton Rouge Parish be severed from all other claims filed in the above captioned matter against defendants Bossier Parish School Board and Nichole Bourgeois, and remain in Division D in the Nineteenth Judicial District Court, East Baton Rouge Parish, Louisiana," should be reversed.
