
In Re: The Baton Rouge Clinic (A Medical Corporation),

BEFORE: PARRO, McDONALD, AND CRAIN, JJ.

WRIT GRANTED IN PART; WRIT DENIED IN PART. We conclude that the trial court abused its discretion in ordering the Special Master's report of May 19, 2014, be produced to the parties without limiting its distribution to the parties, their attorneys, and their economic experts and enjoining them from further dissemination of the information contained therein. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the special master's report dated May 19, 2014, shall be released to the parties with an injunction that the contents of the report be disclosed only to the parties, their counsel of record, and their pertinent economic experts. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all documents and reports produced and released to the parties pursuant to this order, including all copies not destroyed, shall be returned at the conclusion of their use or at the conclusion of the litigation, whichever occurs first.
