R.S. 15:1171(B) grants authority to the Department of Public Safety and Corrections to adopt administrative remedy procedures to receive, hear, and dispose of complaints of time computations of sentences. Any complaint pertaining to the time computation must be made under the Corrections Administrative Remedy Procedure (CARP) as provided in La. R.S. 15:1171-15:1179.
