WRIT NOT CONSIDERED. Relator failed to comply with Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal, Rule 4-5(A), by failing to include in the affidavit the telephone numbers of the judge and opposing counsel. Relator also failed to comply with Rules 4-5(C)(5), (8) and (10) in that the application does not contain a memorandum that briefs the claims presented for review, a copy of the bill of information, and the pertinent court minutes, if any. Moreover, although it is not a violation of the Uniform Rules, we note that relator failed to include a copy of the trial transcript. See **City of Baton Rouge v. Plain**, 433 So.2d 710 (La.), cert. denied, 464 U.S. 896, 104 S.Ct. 246, 78 L.Ed.2d 235 (1983). Accordingly, this Court cannot adequately review the trial court's ruling herein. Supplementation of this writ application and/or an application for rehearing will not be considered. See Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal, Rules 2-18.7 & 4-9. In the event relator elects to file a new application with this Court, the application shall be filed on or before October 9, 2014. Any future filing on this issue should include the entire contents of this application, the missing items noted above, and a copy of this ruling.
