

**BEFORE: WHIPPLE, C.J., GUIDRY AND McCLENDON, JJ.**

**WRIT GRANTED.** An order granting either a preliminary or a final injunction or a temporary restraining order shall describe in reasonable detail, and not by mere reference to the petition or other documents, the act or acts sought to be restrained. La. Code Civ. P. art. 3605. The judgment before this Court fails to describe the act or acts being enjoined, the parties subject to the injunction, or whether the injunction is preliminary or permanent, resulting in the judgment being invalid and void for lack of specificity. We grant relators', Marshall Parker and Mark Parker's, writ and vacate the trial court's May 19, 2016 ruling. The matter is remanded to the trial court for further proceedings.
